HealthInsurance.com National Survey of 1,000 Adults  
 Conducted May 6-10, 2021 by Scott Rasmussen for healthinsurance.com

Field work for the survey was conducted by RMG Research, Inc.

Certain quotas were applied to the overall sample and lightly weighted by geography, gender, age, race, education, internet use, and political party to reasonably reflect the nation's population. Other variables were reviewed to ensure that the final sample is representative of that population.
